

CrossRoads Missions Internship Programs

Statement of Purpose

CrossRoads Missions provides opportunities for hands on experiences working in the atmosphere of a mission's organization. Our goal is to better equip individuals by providing a cross-cultural mission experience. We hope that after an internship one will consider continuing some capacity of ministry.

Description

Internships are summer long opportunities. Most weeks a group of teenagers and their adult leaders arrive at our sites (Mexico, Appalachia-Kentucky, Inner-City Louisville & Cincinnati, New Orleans & Help Build Hope). The staff on site (full-time & interns) facilitate the mission trip. From breakfast until lights out, interns serve with the participants, build community, lead construction crews, cook meals, organize outreach projects, lead small group devotions and spend time getting to know the participants & locals. During the internship, the staff teams spend time in spirited & in depth discussions on biblical, religious and social matters. Every day has the potential to be different from the day before, flexibility is the key.

(CrossRoads Missions does not require college aged interns to raise support for their internship. College Interns are paid \$1000 for the full summer.)

High School Students

- Must be at least 16 yrs. old and have completed your junior year of HS
- These internships are half summer and are available in **Appalachia, KY ONLY**.

(CrossRoads Missions does require High School interns to raise support for their internship. A \$300 student participation fee is required of all HS interns).
