The Power of Stories

Stories have been used for centuries to teach, inspire, humor, scare, entertain and inform. Jesus used parables extensively in his teachings. Stories of hope, courage and beauty still have the power to change the world.

Purpose

Storytellers exists to partner with local missions, ministries and churches helping them to tell their story and the stories of those they serve. We do this with volunteer participants skilled in journalism, photography, videography, graphic-design and other communication related fields, as well as those wishing to learn how to tell these stories more effectively.

Need

There are many ministries and organizations across the world that excel in providing care, aid and hope to those in physical, emotional and spiritual need. However they are not all able, either technically or financially, to effectively share their work with their partners and supporters. Storytellers partners with these ministries and organizations to help them share their vision, their successes and the great need for their services.

Mission Information

CrossRoads Missions partners with various local ministries and organizations. These ministries work might be primarily focused on humanitarian aid, evangelism, outreach or other ministries.

Participants in storytellers will work with these organizations to prepare cohesive multimedia resources. (printed books/brochures, video, photography, etc. depending on the skill sets of the participants)

These organizations can then use these resources to inspire, enlist and encourage partners and supporters.

During a storytellers trip, participants learn how to effectively use their gifts to tell the stories of the people, communities and ministries they encounter. Storytellers is, in part a traveling workshop for those who want to learn the craft and for those looking to hone their skills.



Schedule

A typical week or multi-week trip includes:

Praise/devotions/teaching - Worship is a focus of each trip, we have times of personal devotions and teaching to prepare and challenge us throughout the week.

Media projects - CrossRoads Missions staff will lead you in a wide variety of media and documentary projects. Trained staff and interns will supervise the gathering and production of these projects to aid the various agencies CrossRoads Missions works with.

Workshop/training programs - During the week groups will learn how to better use their gifts to affect real change in their audience. Each trip is aimed at different skill levels, from beginner to professional.

Fellowship - During the week you will spend time in fellowship with one another, the staff of CrossRoads Missions, the staff of local organizations as well as local community members.

Cost

The participant fee covers supplies for the media projects, outreach, lodging, meals and supplies for worship and devotions. This DOES NOT include transportation, travel meals, souvenirs or equipment. CrossRoads Missions has a limited supply of equipment.

Week Long \$525.00 per person*

Two Weeks \$800.00 per person*

*These are estimates and could be higher or lower depending on specific needs of each field.



Transportation

CrossRoads Missions does not provide transportation for the field except for international trips. The cost of airfare is not included in the above cost list. The participant is required to use their vehicles to travel to/from the work sites and living facilities. For some trips, travel to Louisville, Ky. will also be required.

Lodging

Lodging facilities will vary for each trip. Do not expect first-class accommodations.

Meals

Meals will vary depending on the field, expect to eat local cuisine. Sharing meals with local workers and families is likely.

Age/Skill Requirements

Trips outside the United States are for adults and college students 18 and older. Participants in these trips should have some experience, either professionally or in a classroom. Some trips in the United States and Mexico are open to younger students and those with less or no experience.
